- Sharing Information and Knowledge:

 - Spain and the USOC
 - Finland and Spain
- Expert exchange program of sport science
- 2-3 weeks stays to study and to work in other country
- Important to collect information how it worked and how to improve it
- We knew that we had not a lot of time to plan, to make arrangements, to realize
- Sender pays travelling and receiver takes care of accomodation and meals - policy











Spain – USA - plan

- Partners: USOC and CAR Sierra Nevada
- Spain -> USA: Head of Biomechanics from CAR Sierra Nevada stayed one week in Chula Vista and other week in Colorado
- Contact persons planned visit as well as possible
- Objective in the USA was to familiarize conditions and possibilities how to cooperate in the future
- Schedule very tight
- Other part (USA -> Spain) is still waiting its realization
 - Planning is going
 - One management area person goes to Spain

Finland – Spain - plan

- Partners:
 - ◆ HPC Vierumäki and HPC Vuokatti Finland
 - ◆ CAR Sierra Nevada Spain
- Finland -> Spain:
 - One swimming coach/researcher from Vierumäki at Sierra Nevada for 10 days
 - Objective: Swimming biomechanics
- Spain -> Finland:
 - One biomechanists stayed for two weeks in Vuokatti and Vierumäki
 - Objective: Research and testing in skiing events and swimming and other sports

■ Finlandia:

- Many new ideas (cooperation / integration)
- ◆ Collaboration University HPC
- ◆ Schedule very tight
- ◆ Positive win-win –example (Finland tecnology+winter, Spain resourses +altitude+summer)











Feedback – CAR Sierra Nevada

Chula Vista and Colorado:

- ◆ Need of previous planning and schedule (Athletes Commitments, Staff Agenda, Research possibilities...)
- ◆ Need of Coaches and Staff implication. (we don't copy, we share and apply on, depending of each centre needs).
- ◆ Allow the "Subject" to get involved within the centre activities as a new member of the staff.
- ◆ Tray to arrange research projects or real cooperation activities in which the main favoured will be the athletes.
- ◆ If possible, try to send to 2 person from different departments to the same Centre.











General Feedback

- Positive feedback generally
- Planning needs more time
- Good way to exchange the best practises
- Benefits now and later
- Helps you to know what you don't know
- Way to motivate your people and performance of center











What to improve - possibilities

- Needs time
- No visit but stays
- Long-term planning beforehand if possible
 - ◆ Visits planning long-term projects
- Harmonization
- Also areas of management, maintenance, marketing etc.
- More than two countries together
