


# 1. GB got second

## 2. Russia went down to 4th


→ 18 Medals in Athletics (2008 and 2012) would have placed Russia second in number





# 3. Japan's tracking upwards


→ Japan is well positioned to get into the top 5 at 2020 home Games






# 5. Australia's tracking downwards

→ AUS stays at its lowest after Sydney 2000













# Spain: tracking on Medal Count

# Rio 2016 Medal Conversion Rate






# Spain: W.Champs. medal conversion



