$\rightarrow 1$ Gold in Atlanta 96
$\rightarrow$ From 10th to 4th 2004-2008
$\rightarrow$ Improvement post home Games

## 2. Russia went down to 4th

$\rightarrow 18$ Medals in Atheltics (2008 and 2012) would have placed Russia second in number

## Spanish HP going forward

$\rightarrow$ Performance ceiling on 17 medals
$\rightarrow$ Cut funding did not impact on mediumterm Olympic results
$\rightarrow$ Efficiency will be key with no funding increase likely to happen.
$\rightarrow$ Key investment decisions...
> Funding allocation with more sports in the Olympic programme
Athlete's grants allocation
