

#### What is the Centers Network about?

- It is the set of oficial **CENTERS RECOGNICED** by the Superior Sport Board (CSD) that guarantee the technical and sport preparation of the athletes both in **HIGH COMPETITION** and **TECHNICALIZATION** through the **SPORTS PROGRAMMES**.
- 52 acredited Centers by Superior Sport Board (CSD).
- 307 acredited Sports Programmes by Superior Sport Board (CSD).
- Nearly 5.000 all categories athletes.



#### Why is the Centers Network created?

- Athletes training taking part in high level competitions require centers including the best premises, services and technical resources.
- **TO MEET THESE REQUIEREMENTS**, Sports Perfomance Centers (SPC), Sports Technification Centers (STC) and Specialised Centers (SC) have been developed to train and search future high level talents.



#### Which are the Centers Network Objetives?

- OFFER the athletes THE BEST TRAINING CONDITIONS in their home places thus avoiding having to move to big Centers in the early ages.
- **CONTRIBUTE TO THE COORDINATION** amongst the concerned Institution (CSD, Autonomous Regions, Spanish Federations, Autonomous Federations and Centers).
- BOOTS, SUPORT AND PROMOTE more efficiently State Sports Programmes awarded by Spanish Federations.
- ENCOURAGE NEW SPORTS PROGRAMMES creation in the Centers.
- **VISUALICE** in a simple and effective way the Spanish Federations **SPORT CORES** in each Autonomous Region.
- GREATER EFFICIENCY to AWARD sport activity GRANTS in the Centers.



# Who and How are the Sport Centers and Programmes classified?

- Superior Sport Board (CSD).
- 10th January 2014 Resolution: **SPORTS PREMISES** and **PROGRAMMES** to be classified to enhance hihg level competition development.



### 10th January 2014 Resolution to classify Sport Centers and Programmes

- Clasification criteria have been adapted meeting the Center NEEDS AND THE EXISTING SPORTS REALITY IN OUR COUNTRY TO GIVE SPANISH ATHLETES A BETTER SERVICES EFFECTIVENESS. Alongside these better economic resources need to be guaranteed, optimised and invested in the best way from CSD to Spanish Federations.
- In alignment to the INTEREST, OBJETIVES, QUALITY OF THE PREMISES AND THE SERVICES, RESOURCES, SPORTS PROGRAMMES AND THE DIFERENT DEPARTAMENTS OR SPECIFIC UNITS THEY WERE CREATED FOR.

SPORT TECHNIFICATION CENTERS (STC/CTD)

Autonomic and/or local and/or Sports Federations sport MULTIDISCIPLINARY venues aim to meet the athletes improvement (mainly in LOWER CATEGORIES) which activity is mainly developed in the AUTONOMIC/LOCAL SCOPE.

#### SPECIALICED CENTERS:

Public autonimic, local and Sports Federations sportive venues aiming at become sportive and specialized training Centers for specific sport forms which can not be met either in the SPC/CAR or in STC/CTD.


.- SPECIALICED HIGH PERFORMANCE CENTERS (SHPC / CEAR)
Centers where ONLY ONE SPORT MODALITY is developed and aims to improve the sport performance providing HIGH LEVEL ATHLETES with the BEST TRAINING CONDITIONS as well as category for the sports Spanish Federation trainining needs as a priority.

.- SPECIALICED SPORTS TECHNIFICATION CENTERS (SSTC / CETD)

Centers where ONLY ONE SPORT MODALITY is developed providing the athletes improvement (mainly in LOWER CATEGORIES) which activity is mainly developed in the AUTONOMIC/LOCAL SCOPE.




# SHPC/CEAR and SSTC/CETD Geographic Distribution

HIGH PERFORMANCE PROGRAMME (HP/AR)

SUPERVISED PROGRAMMES by each SPANISH FEDERATIONS mainly aimed at ABSOLUTE CATEGORIE and NATIONAL TEAM athletes and in certain cases to lower category athletes in the INTERNATIONAL SCOPE.



# Types of Sports Programmes High Performance Programmne (HP/AR)

#### HIGH PERFORMANCE PROGRAMME (HP/AR)

- Athletes belonging to National Teams.
- **■** Absolute category athletes.
- Athletes with relevant results at an international level.
- Spanish Champion athletes in the absolute category.
- **-** High level athlets (HLA/DAN).
- Spanish Federation technical support team in charge of the programme.



# Types of Sports Programmes Public Technification Sport Programme (PT/E)

PUBLIC TECHNIFICATION SORT PROGRAMME (PT/E)

**SUPERVISED PROGRAMMES** by each **SPANISH FEDERATIONS** aimed at **LOWER CATEGORY** athletes whose activity is developed in the **NATIONAL** or **INTERNATIONAL SCOPE**.



# Types of Sports Programmes Public Technification Sport Programme (PT/E)

#### PUBLIC TECHNIFICATION SPORT PROGRAMME (PT/E)

- Lower category National Teams athletes.
- Spanish Champion athletes from lower categories.
- Athletes with relevant results at a national level.
- Athletes talented from lower categories.
  - **-** High level athlets (HLA/DAN).
  - Spanish Federation technical support team in charge of the programme.



### Types of Sports Programmes Autonomous Technification Sport Programme (AT/A)

AUTONOMOUS TECHNIFICATION SPORT PROGRAMME (AT/A)

**SUPERVISED PROGRAMMES** by each **AUTNOMIC FEDERATIONS** aiming at the athletes advanced improvement and whose activity is developed in the **AUTONOMIC SCOPE**.



### Types of Sports Programmes Autonomous Technification Sport Programme (AT/A)

#### AUTONOMOUS TECHNIFICATION SPORT PROGRAMME (AT/A)

- Athletes talented in their regions (Autonomic Selections).
- Absolute y lower categories athletes.
- Atlethes with relevant results at local and autonomic level.





### Rio 2016 Olympic Games. Spanish Team Centers Network Usage
