CENTERS

The INTERNATIONAL COUNCIL FOR COACH EDUCATION, ICCE and the INTERNATIONAL
ASSOCIATION OF HIGH PERFORMANCE SPORT TRAINING CENTERS, IAHPSTC
(hereinafter referred to as the "Parties"),

RECOGNISING the importance of sustaining and developing sports.

DESIRING to strengthen the existing friendly relations and co-operation between the two
Parties

HAVE REACHED THE FOLLOWING UNDERSTANDING:

Paragraph 1

GENERAL OBJECTIVES

This Memorandum of Understanding provides the framework within which detailed proposals for scientific and educational programs for the sports groups in the centers, are to be jointly considered between the Parties on the basis of reciprocity and mutual benefit.

This Memorandum of Understanding is a statement of intention between the parties in relation to the issues mentioned in the Memorandum of Understanding. It is not intended that this Memorandum of Understanding create any contractual relationship or that it be legally binding on the parties.

Paragraph 2

FRAMEWORK


The Parties intend to encourage and facilitate, as appropriate, the education environment for all the involved people of the organization to share their knowledge and experience related to the development of an honest and healthy sport practice in their training sites.

Paragraph 3

FIELDS OF CO-OPERATION .

The primary objective of this Memorandum of Understanding is to cooperate together and make international studies about training and educational centres and sharing opportunities related to the to work together with third parties to improve an awareness about training and coach education centres.

In order to pursue the above Framework and primary objective of co-operation, either Party may propose specific arrangements and / or additional fields of cooperation of mutual benefit for consideration by other Party. Yearly activities or projects are described in the annex that will attach with this memorandum.



Paragraph 4

FORMS OF CO-OPERATION

Co-operation under this Memorandum of Understanding is intended to include:

- a. Developing an Evaluation System about training and coach education centres in the world.
- b. Exchange of information on coach training, including information provided by coaches and athletes in order to improve the quality of the education materials.
- c. Supplies of experts, in the congresses.
- d. Interaction through new technologies on teaching with the use of Internet and advanced interactive content management systems.
- e. Try to organize the ICCE Congress and the Forum on Elite Sports in the same place and together in the next years.

Paragraph 5

FUNDING

The present Memorandum of Understanding is intended to exclude any direct cost by the parties.

Relations are entered into between the ICCE and IAHPSTC to further promote the benefits of the relationship developed by this Memorandum of Understanding in the lead up to the 2012 Olympic Games in London.

Paragraph 6


IMPLEMENTATION

- a. The Parties intend to make arrangements for the implementation and development of specific educational programs provided by both parties until 2012.
- b. Such arrangements will cover the subjects of co-operation procedures treatment of intellectual property, and other appropriate matters;.

Paragraph 7

AMENDMENT

This Memorandum of Understanding may be amended by mutual consent in writing between the Parties.

SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTE

Any dispute between the Parties arising out of the interpretation or implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding is expected to be settled amicably by consultation or negotiation.

Paragraph 9

CONSULTATIONS

The Parties are expected to consult together upon request of either Party regarding any matter relating to the terms of this Memorandum of Understanding.

Paragraph 10

COMING INTO EFFECT AND TERMINATION

This Memorandum of Understanding is intended to come into effect on the date of its signing. It is expected to remain in effect at the end of the Olympic Games, London 2012.


