 - Aalto University is one of Urhea's founding members






Practical support for combining sports career with studies

1. Personal study support for athletes


- Personal support for planning dual career and studies

- Flexibility with exam dates and locations

3. Appreciation and utilizing sportsrelated life learning

- University supports athletes in employability and in conceptualizing their sparts-learnings



4. High school transition support

- Co-operation with regional (sportsfocused) high schools
- Providing future students with realistic dual career expectations
- Helps athlete-students in work-life questions

5. Communication and cooperation between Urhea and NOC

- University leadership ensures the staff is familiar with dual-career support
